Hebrews 1 points repeatedly to the majesty and \_\_\_deity\_\_\_ of Christ. See verses 1,2,8, etc.

Hebrews 2 points us to the dignity of man by quoting Psalm 8 but suggests that we have not realized the \_\_\_dominion\_\_\_ that God created us to enjoy.

3. He is our \_\_\_BROTHER\_\_\_.  
He is not ashamed to call us \_\_\_BROTHERS\_\_\_.  
In ancient times one’s ancestry was most important.  
Look at the ancestry of Christ.
